



Social Health Insurance in India: *The National Health Insurance Scheme, RSBY, with a Sum Assured of Rs. 30,000 is being offered to "Below-Poverty-Line" families and other such population at a subsidised fee of Rs. 30 for covering hospitalisation expenses. The scheme is being implemented by Ministry of Labour and Employment, Government of India with the help of respective State Nodal Agencies.*

Human Development Index (HDI), 2011




Expenditure on Health (%), India





Social Security Expenditure and Out-of-Pocket Expenditure on Health, India




